

Cell C's Camerer to take marketing reins at MultiChoice

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[Simon Camerer](#), the man who "appointed" comedian Trevor Noah as Cell C's CEO ("[chief experience officer](#)") and who led the makeover of the cellular operator's brand, is set to take the top sales and marketing job at DStv operator MultiChoice on 1 February 2012.

Camerer resigned as Cell C's marketing director at the end of last year after seven years in the position. He hinted at the time of his departure that a restructuring at Cell C, led by former acting CEO [Simon Duffy](#), played a role in his decision.

He is expected to replace MultiChoice's current sales and marketing director, [Graham Pfuhl](#), who is set to retire from the pay-TV operator.
