

MultiChoice will pay settlement of \$37.3m to Nigerian tax authorities

Africa's biggest pay TV company MultiChoice Group said on Thursday its subsidiaries have reached a settlement with Nigerian tax authorities and agreed to pay a total tax amount of about \$37.3m.

Nigeria's Federal Inland Revenue Service (FIRS) froze MultiChoice Nigeria's accounts in 2022 and served MultiChoice Group with a \$1.27bn tax claim for its Nigeria operation and a \$342m claim for value-added taxes.
