

McCormick Property Development breaks ground at Mamelodi Square

Rural retail development specialists McCormick Property Development (MPD) broke ground at Mamelodi Square earlier this month. Developed in partnership with Putprop Limited, Mamelodi Square will be a single-level enclosed mall spanning over $16.000m^2$.

Located directly off the main arterial of Tsamaya Road in Mamelodi, the site was previously utilised as a bus depot for Putco. Confirmed tenants to date include Shoprite, Capitec Bank, Clicks, KFC, Power Fashion and the Pepkor group. It is anticipated that the development will create approximately 420 local labour positions during construction with an anticipated 950 permanent positions created once the centre is open for trade.

Construction of the Mall is anticipated to take approximately 15 months with an anticipated opening date in the final quarter of 2022.

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
